ABOUT CONFERENCE

Scientists, industry specialists, heads and professors of higher education institutions, research institutes, educational organizations, postgraduate students, master's students, and talented students are invited to participate in the conference.

Place and time of the conference: Institute for Retraining and Professional Development of Higher Education Personnel, September 29, 2026

The deadline for abstract submission for the conference is July 1, 2026.

Conference languages: Uzbek, Russian and English.

Conference Objective: The conference aims to scientifically analyze current issues related to the use of artificial intelligence technologies in the education system, discuss innovative approaches and best international practices and develop effective mechanisms for improving the quality of education using artificial intelligence.

SCIENTIFIC DIRECTIONS OF CONFERENCE:

1. Management and strategic development of education based on artificial intelligence
2. Innovative mechanisms for implementing artificial intelligence technologies in the professional development of management and pedagogical staff
3. Digital platforms and services supporting the educational process
4. Ethical, legal and social issues in the use of artificial intelligence

REGISTRATION OF CONFERENCE MATERIALS:

Thesis submissions will be accepted until July 1, 2026, via the www.conf.bimm.uz online platform. Please submit your abstracts no later than this deadline.



Each thesis will be selected by a working group. Selected abstracts will be posted and indexed in the international scientific databases Index Copernicus, Zenodo, OpenAIRE, CyberLeninka and Google Scholar, as well as on the www.bimm.uz platform.

The fee for posting an abstract in these databases and platforms is 130,000 (one hundred thirty thousand) soums per thesis.

*Each conference participant will receive a certificate of participation.

ТРЕБОВАНИЯ К МАТЕРИАЛАМ ДЛЯ КОНФЕРЕНЦИИ:

The issues raised in the article, the description of the research method, the author's results, data and conclusions should be concise and clear.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CONFERENCE MATERIALS:

The text format is Microsoft Word, with a line spacing of 1.5 pt and a font size of Times New Roman 14 Point. The text margins should be 2.0 cm top and bottom, 3 cm left, and 1.5 cm right, and aligned to the text width.

At the top of the article, the article title should be written in capital letters between lines, and on the right side, the author's full information should be provided, leaving one line between lines: last name, first name, patronymic, place of affiliation, academic degree and rank, telephone number, (for students) name of educational institution, field of research and specialty, and email address.

Given that the selected articles will be included in international databases such as Index Copernicus, Zenodo, OpenAIRE, CyberLeninka, and Google Scholar, and that this process is a paid service, please provide the author's telephone number for feedback.

Line breaks are required for the abstract, keywords, main text, and bibliography. The number of authors of an abstract should not exceed three (3). Each author may submit a thesis or article with up to one (1) authorship.

The list of references (footnotes) is provided at the end of the page. The dissertation should be 3-5 pages long, and its field of study should be indicated in the article title (e.g., I-N. Mirzaeva).

Theses with an originality level of over 70% are included in the conference proceedings.

The order of citations and references: the source citation is provided in large parentheses, along with the author's last name, year of publication, and page number. For example: [Nematov, 2005; 56]. The list of references is provided at the end of the text in alphabetical order. The number of references must be at least five.

Theses that do not meet these requirements will not be accepted. The author is responsible for the accuracy of examples, excerpts, and information used in the text. The organizing committee is not obligated to return rejected theses to the authors or provide comments.
